

CLUB POLICY # 202

Club Membership Badges

1.0 Annual members are issued badges to which an annual sticker for that year is attached. Annual memberships expire on the 31st of each December.

1.1 Members on the range will display a badge with a current sticker either on their person or in an easily seen location on their shooting gear. If an annual member displays an out of date sticker on his/her badge, that annual member will be asked to renew membership or pay the daily fee, before continuing using range facilities.

1.2 Life members have badges which are identified as "Life Member."

1.3 All membership badges are the property of Gateway

2.0 GRPC has a long standing policy of family membership.

2.1 The member, his/her spouse and their children, and grandchildren under the age of eighteen are within the definition of a family membership.

2.2 The spouse or children are eligible to have a temporary badge (same as a daily member's badge) issued to them when accompanied by the member.

3.0 If the spouse of an annual or life member wishes to use the facilities on a more regular basis, the more permanent badge issued to annual and life members (as applicable) can be issued to the spouse, under the following conditions:

3.1 ***To apply for a spouse badge.*** the member's spouse must be accompanied by the member, The Club ***member will certify that the spouse and member are in a legal marriage.***

3.2 The spouse must view the safety video and pass the written test. Once taken, the video viewing and written test will not be required on renewals.

3.2 After compliance with 3.1 and 3.2 above, the spouse can use the facilities without being accompanied by the husband or wife member.
