

CLUB POLICY # 204

Guests and Children's Policy:

1.0 Annual members and life members may bring a guest on a one time basis within a twelve month period at ½ the daily rate. Family members of annual or life members under the age of 18 are not guests but are part of the family membership.

1.1 A life or annual member can only bring one (1) adult guest per visit and the guest must view the safety video and pass. In effect, the guest becomes a day member but received a discount on the daily fee for day members.

1.2 The member will be responsible for his/her guest's conduct to include following all rules.

2.0 Members can take no more than three guests (day members or guests) at any one time into the ranges restricted for annual and life members only, with the exception of Range 8 (100 yds) where only one guest is allowed.

3.0 Out of town match participants who come to participate in scheduled matches are to be afforded the privilege of practicing on the range to be used for the match one day in advance without paying the daily member fee. These out of town guests will be required to wear identification badges, as issued by the match director. These out of town guests for matches will be required to observe any and all Club rules and safety policy.

4.0 Young shooters under the age of 16, when accompanied *and closely supervised* by *an adult* member (*daily, annual or life*), may shoot without charge. *Closely supervised means that the adult member must be close enough (arms length) to physically restrain the minor if need be. The adult cannot be shooting concurrently with the minor. Young shooters under 16 are not required to pass the written safety test.*

5.0 *Young shooters 16 years of age and under 18 years of age pay half the appropriate daily fee when accompanied by an adult daily member but they are required to view the safety video and pass the written test. These young shooters may shoot concurrently with the day member from a nearby shooting position.*
