

CLUB POLICY 206

USE OF GRPC MAIN BUILDINGS

1. Club building # 1 (the large old building) is for use as the Club office and Club store. ***The primary use of the large room known as the Board Room, its large table and office type chairs is for meetings of the Board of Directors which are normally at night. The Board Room is not a lounge area for GRPC members or guests. The large outdoor pavilion is suitable for such use. The Board Room may also be used as a meeting room for GRPC activities. A small meeting room is available for BOD committee meetings or scheduled meetings by members and/shooting disciplines. The large training room is utilized primarily for viewing of the safety video for daily members.***

2. ***Building # 2 (the large new building i.e. the Craig Building)*** has a dual function. Priority one is for Club meetings and large Club events. Second priority is when Club meetings are not scheduled, the GRPC Junior Club has its use for an indoor air gun range. Junior Club activities are normally at night or afternoons and occasionally for use as needed on weekends. The various Women's programs also have access for their scheduled events. There are several spaces that can be utilized simultaneously for different events.

3. The office room adjacent to the assembly hall is for the exclusive use of the Junior Club.

USE OF THE LARGE PAVILLION

1. The primary purpose is for Club events as a whole.
2. Exclusive use of the pavilion by other Club groups or by GRPC related groups is permitted when scheduled through the main Club office.
3. When the two above are not in use, the pavilion may be use by individual Club members or small groups of Club members.
