CLUB POLICY #302

Policy 302: Range Officers/Range Safety Officers

- 1.0 It is the intent of the Board that Range Officers shall supervise the activities of all shooting on the ranges. This supervision is primarily oriented towards safety but may also include asking for proof of membership or helping to enforce rules and policy.
- 2.0 An armband, shirt or hat marked "Range Officer" must be worn at all time when acting as a range officer.
- 3.0 A training program will be established by the Range Officer Chief Instructor. Emphasis will be on:
 - 3.1 Using tact, non-confrontational verbal and body language when correcting any Club member, (daily, annual or life) on the ranges.
 - 3.2 Correct knowledge of existing range and safety rules.
 - 3.3 What to do and how to act if a confrontation does occur and what to avoid.
 - 3.4 Proper use of incident reports for gross violations of rules or safety procedures.
 - 3.5 Operate under the guidelines outlined in policies 301 and 304.
- 3.0 All safety officers must pass this course and be approved by the Chief Range Safety Officer.
